## **Call for Abstracts**

All participants are invited to submit an abstract for an oral presentation or poster. Abstract submission is available only by e-mail, thus filling out the Abstract Submission Form and sending it by e-mail to: <a href="mailto:vladimir.stupar@sf.unibl.org">vladimir.stupar@sf.unibl.org</a> is required. Ensure that you register first before submitting the abstract. The official language of the conference is English; therefore, authors are kindly advised to proofread their abstracts, as they will be printed 'as is'. Abstracts will be accepted upon the payment of the **Basic registration fee**.

Deadline for the abstract submission (and Basic fee payment) is May 1, 2024.

#### **Accommodation**

There is plenty of accommodation options in Banja Luka in proximity of the venue (hotels, B&Bs, hostels, apartments) which can be easily booked online. If this is your choice, we recommend apartments, but feel free to contact us any time for assistance.

However, we can recommend rooms in a dormitory inside the University campus, just a couple of hundred meters from the meeting venue. Rooms are double standard/twin with internet, air-condition and free parking. The price is around €18-20 per person (depending on whether it is occupied by one or two persons), including breakfast (served in the restaurant 50 m from the venue) and taxes. Those interested in this accommodation should inform us, and we will make further arrangements. Since there are currently only 10 of these rooms available for our dates, it would be best to book as soon as possible. Anyway, we should inform them about the number of rooms needed by 15 March. In case there are more applicants than available rooms, priority will be given to those who applied first.

#### **Useful Information**







With the population of around 180,000, Banja Luka is the academic, financial, and administrative center of Republika Srpska (one of the two entities in Bosnia & Herzegovina). It is located in a valley at the crossing point between the Dinaric Plains in the south and the Pannonian Basin in the North at 164 m a.s.l. It belongs to the Central European Time-zone (GMT+1), and has a moderate-continental climate with predominant Pannonian influences. The average annual temperature is 10.7 °C, with an average of 0.8 °C in January and 21.3 °C in July.

Although there is an airport nearby (23 km), to the simplest way to reach Banja Luka is by car or bus. The city is connected via highway to Zagreb (184 km), Belgrade (330 km), Ljubljana (325 km) and Sarajevo (254 km).

The venue is easily accessible from the city center by foot, however, there is public transportation (bus no. 14) which costs around €1,50 per ride, or taxi (around €1,00 per km).

The currency in Bosnia and Herzegovina is the Convertible Mark (BAM), with an approximate exchange rate of 2,00 BAM for €1,00 (1.95 to be exact).

#### **Payment & Fees**

The **Basic registration fee** for regular participants is **€40** (80 BAM), which cover:

- Wednesday welcome reception;
- Thursday lunch and coffee/tea-breaks;
- Meeting Pack with programme.

**Accompanying persons** are exempt from paying the **basic fee**, however, they will be charged the full price for the **excursions** and the **gala dinner**.

Fees for **meeting excursions** (Friday and Saturday) are €30 (60 BAM) per excursion, inclusive of transportation and lunch. The optional Vrbas River rafting tour is not included in the price.







The **Social Dinner** fee (Thursday evening) is **€45** (90 BAM) (in the restaurant located in the city center).

#### **Excursions**

#### Excursion 1: Vlašić Mt., June 21, 2024

We will depart at 9:00 and return around 18:00, depending on traffic and other events.

Site 1: Serpentinite complex Mlinska rijeka with specific ultramafic xeric vegetation of rocky graslands and rock outcrops.

Site 2: Mountain Vlašić, named after the ancient people of Vlasi, is one of the largest mountain plateaus in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Mount Vlašić is located in the very centre of Bosnia and Herzegovina within the Central Bosnia Canton. The Vlašić plateau extends from 1,000 to 1,500 m, while the highest peak of Vlašić, Paljenik, reaches a height of 1,934 m. We will walk through subalpine Dinaric grasslands up to the top of the mountain. On our way we will also check out the vegetation of subalpine Dinaric limestone cliffs (Devečanske stijene), as well as vegetation of subalpine spruce and beech forests.

Site 3: Lunch will be served at the Eco Zone Ugarski brzaci (translated as "Rapids of the Ugar River"), which features its own trout farm.

Site 4: A stop at the restaurant "Kanjon" with a coffee break and the option to take a walk along the canyon trail through thermophilous forests leading to the gravel banks of the Ugar River.









Excursion 2: Vrbas River canyon., June 22, 2024 We will depart at 9:00 and return around 15:00.

Passing through the city of Banja Luka, the Vrbas River is a major river (with a length of 250 km) in Bosnia and Herzegovina. It appears at the southern slope of the Vranica mountain near the town of Gornji Vakuf, at around 1,530 m (5,020 ft) above sea level and it drains central part of the northern slopes of the Dinaric mountain massif. The **Upper Vrbas** is a section between its source and town of Jajce, encompassing entire valley between Bugojno, Gornji Vakuf-Uskoplje and Donji Vakuf, and the gorge between Donji Vakuf and Jajce. The **Middle** 







**Vrbas** mostly comprises a canyon section, with steep slopes and narrow passages, between Jajce and Banja Luka. The **Lower Vrbas** is the final section of the river, passing through lowlands of Lijevče Polje, as it approaches the Sava River. It joins the Sava river at the elevation of around 90 m above sea level. Our excursion will focus on the Middle Vrbas section.

Site 1: Hot springs at Vrućica near Banjaluka with relict chasmophytic communities of Adiantum capillus-veneris.

Site 2: Ljubačevo, with ethno-village museum, thermophilous forests, dry grasslands and meadows, limestone cliff vegetation and the best view over the Canyon Tijesno.

Site 3: Krupa na Vrbasu, with beautiful Krupa River (only 4 km long), with cascades, distinct karstic phenomena, old wooden water-mills, medieval monastery Krupa etc. From here, it is possible to take a rafting tour (1.5-2 hours) to the Rafting Center Canyon where we will have a lunch.

Site 4: Lunch at Rafting Center Kanjon.
